The 20th IEEE International Symposium on Robot and Human Interactive Communication will be in Atlanta, GA at the Hotel Palomar next to the Georgia Institute of Technology Campus.

The theme of the symposium is cognition and interaction for real-world human-robot cooperation.

Prospective authors should submit their papers electronically in PDF format. Six pages in the standard IEEE format are allowed for each paper, including figures. Up to two additional pages are permitted at extra charge. Each paper can be accompanied by a short (3-4 minute) video. Special Sessions

Special sessions on advanced topics and innovative applications will be considered, consisting of four to six related papers submitted through the regular review process. Prospective organizers should include a brief statement of purpose for the sessions as well as the abstracts of the papers to be included
